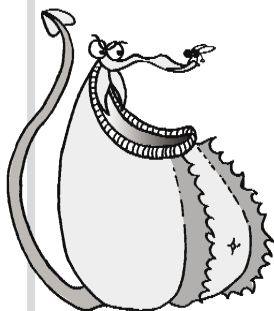
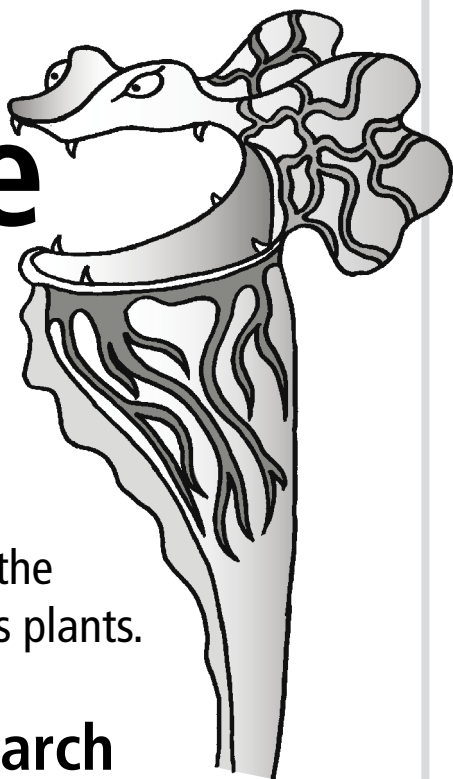

## Australian Carnivorous Plants

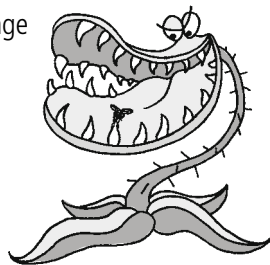
1 pm, Sat 17 March
